



Naturalists engage our visitors in discussion of the importance of biodiversity, preservation of native habitat, ecology of flora and fauna and the history of Bowman's Hill Wildflower Preserve. In addition to leading tours, Naturalists are asked to assist in other education programs, events and fundraisers at the Preserve. Naturalists also enjoy group activities such as field trips, lunch and learn programs, potluck lunches and more.

Naturalists must be members of the Preserve and complete training that includes a series of 17 professional classes plus materials and study guides. There is a \$200 fee for the training. Training begins on September 20, 2018. Classes consist of 5 core training classes and 12 classes in our Knowing Native Plant Series. Candidates will be required to shadow experienced volunteers and conduct "tandem" tours until fully trained. Volunteer Naturalists are responsible for leading at least 5 tours or programs per year after completion of training.
