Thank you for registering to attend the 20th annual Land Ethics Symposium, held Thursday, March 12th at Delaware Valley University in Doylestown, PA. Registration and breakfast begin at 8:00 am and opening remarks at 8:45 am. *Please keep this letter for reference as it contains important information about the Symposium.* Attached is a campus map that you may use to locate parking and building locations.

SYMPOSIUM LOCATION

The Symposium will be held in the **Life Sciences Building, (#24)** located at the corner of Butler Ave. and New Britain Rd. Access parking **(#22)** from the New Britain Rd. entrance **(#3)**.

MAIN PARKING: Use Parking LOT C/Admissions parking lot

Heading SOUTH on State Street/Butler Avenue, turn left on New Britain Road, just past the entrance ramps to Route 611. Make the first right onto Admission Drive. You will see a large parking lot on your right. Please walk to the Life Sciences Building.

Overflow parking: Park in **LOT A** at the main entrance **(#1)**, located at 700 E. Butler Ave. You can follow the signs and walk to the Life Sciences Building (less than 5 minute walk) or catch the shuttle at the **Welcome Center/Public Safety (#2)**. Wait at the "LES Shuttle Stop" and look for the white Del Val van.

FOOD

Your registration includes a continental-style breakfast, beverage service throughout the day, and full lunch. Vegetarian, non-dairy, and gluten-free choices will be available. Breakfast and beverages will be served in the **Life Sciences Building (#24)**. Lunch will be served in the **Levin Dining Hall (#17)**. GENERAL DIRECTIONS TO DEL VAL Additional information and a map are available at www.delval.edu

MAIN ADDRESS: 700 E. Butler Ave., Doylestown, PA 18901 (215) 345-1500

From Philadelphia: Take U.S. Route 611 North (Broad Street) to U.S. Route 202 South. Follow U.S. 202 South ½ mile to University. Or, take U.S. Route 309 North to Route 202 North. Follow U.S. Route 202 North 8 miles to Univ.

From Harrisburg, PA and West: Take the Pa Turnpike East to the Willow Grove Exit 343. Proceed North on U.S. Route 611 to the Chalfont Exit for U.S. Route 202 South. Follow U.S. 202 South ½ mile to the University.

From South New Jersey: Take the N.J. Turnpike to the entrance of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Exit 6 and travel West to Willow Grove Exit 343. Proceed North on U.S. Route 611 to the Chalfont Exit for U.S. 202 South. Follow U.S. 202 South ½ Mile to the University.

From the Allentown, Bethlehem area and points North: Take the Northeast Extension of the PA Turnpike South to the Quakertown Exit. Proceed East on Route 313 in Quakertown. Follow Route 313 to 611 South and turn left at light. University entrance is 3/10 of a mile on the left.

From the New York City area: Take a convenient route to U.S. 202 South. Stay on 202 South through New Jersey to Pennsylvania. Continue on 202 South through Doylestown and look for University entrance on left approximately 1½ miles beyond the town center.
